



Dramatic Cost increases

+ Food : up 38%

+ Gasoline : up 20% - 30%

+ Utilities : up 25%

+ Supplies : up 10% - 75%+ Personnel : up 10% - 18%

Cost per meal increased 35% from 2020 to 2022 and expected to increase 12% more by 2024



Minnesota must have a reliable source of food for frail and food-insecure seniors

- Demand for home-delivered meals continues to climb even as the pandemic ends.
- Hunger Solutions reports 31% increase in food shelf visits by age 60+ adults.
- Workforce shortages are limiting nursing home and homecare options.
 We must meet the basic need for food for frail seniors at home.
